The next item of business was to choose a chairperson to complete a final draft of the land use objectives and action items for Goals One, Two, and Three. Stephen Kreger and Bo McCarver said they would co-chair the last meeting for the land use subcommittee.

Jules Vieau announced that he was looking for volunteers to help with the Rosewood Neighborhood Planning Area Clean-Up for Saturday, **MAY** 19th.

The last item of business was to consider writing a letter of support for the Rosewood Neighborhood Plan. A final draft of the plan was handed out and a decision as to whether to issue a letter of support was delayed until the next team meeting on 5-22-01.
