

Land Use and Transportation Committee Meeting Notes

Introductions

Terry agreed to be voting member

Kerbey Land Café wishes to speak with CNA and Schieffer NA about new location in the ‘hood.

Mark Smolen – community garden – presented revised design with increased number of plots, location further from Schieffer, concessions from PARD (new pathway from Airport to cul-de-sac, trenching for irrigation line, relocation of volleyball court). Needs approval of CNA.

Action: Mark Schiff moved approval, Jules Vieau seconded. Approval was unanimous among those present.

Ray Donley – aerial billboards – desire to regulate or prohibit aerial advertising. Issues of noise, public safety concern on Interstate. Aerial billboards could be considered “off premise signs.” City Council is studying the topic of passing an ordinance to prohibit. August 29 is deadline when Council will decide whether to pursue an ordinance.

Ray will come to the next Steering Committee meeting to ask the CNA to send a resolution to City Council and will bring some suggested language for the resolution.

Girard reported work being done by the Organizational Review Task Force and how it may result in the reorganization of the LUT Committee as a standing committee of the Association.

Jules Vieau – speed bumps on Cherrywood Rd – noted that recent repaving of Cherrywood Rd has degraded the speed bumps there, presenting problems that need to be corrected. He suggested that the SC consider writing a letter to the City seeking remedy.

Meeting adjourned informally around 8:30 pm.
