Call to Order (7:15 PM)

Approval of Meeting Notes

- No motion is taken as LUT does not have a quorum present

Announcements (Girard Kinney)

- *Project Connect*; Latest CapMetro presentation to Alliance for Public Transportation; CP is interested in meeting with CNA
- *Intersection Visibility/Curb Panting*; Recent neighbor concern over plants blocking visibility at intersections; cars also parking too close to curb; objections to red-painted curbs, “hockeysticks” markings preferable but APD cannot enforce these; LUT will have further discussion on the matter
- *Love Your Block Grant* ; Scott Grantham reports grant proposal for rain garden/signage at “triangle” of Dean Keeton/Manor; a proposal has been submitted; Blackland NA is in support of proposal; budget will be \$3500 (grant covers \$1000); Interested in CNA support; LUT suggestion that Scott present to Steering Committee

Reports

- *LUT Reports to SC*; SC has received recommendations from LUT to write letter to 711 developer/owner, write letter to City requesting 6' sidewalk at Maplewood Avenue, revisit Sidewalk Master Plan, and address areas of neighborhood concern regarding Mobility35; SC has not yet taken action on these items
- *Mueller Transportation Committee*; Brendan Wittstruck reports MTC meeting updates; Aldrich roundabout construction is in permitting process; Bike signal grants are underway for Aldrich/Wilshire and Zach Scott/Schieffer intersections at Airport; Mueller NA has approached CNA about re-opening discussion of Airport "longhorns"; CNA originally supported them but does not have a current standing position; 51st Street Vision Plan will provide drawings and information to the public this summer, possibly reconvening the 51st Working Group in early Fall; City Council passed a resolution to create a Parking & Transportation Management District (PTMD) in Mueller

Special Called Meeting of the Steering Committee

- *Mobility35*; TxDOT is looking for CNA input on Mobility35 specifics, including Airport Blvd intersection and proposal to add northbound off-ramp between 32nd and 38 ½ Streets; Suggestion to convene special meeting in July to address topics; Questions regarding local business input in process—CNA will bring businesses into conversation; No action taken but special meeting was called for May 5th; only meeting attendees were informed and no notice was sent
- *ANC-East Resolution*; ANC-East has declined CNA request to postpone vote; CNA Chair Katie Halloran has created first draft of CNA response letter; CNA SC Special Meeting to prepare consensus on responses to content of this letter; **Motion to appoint Katie Halloran to be alternative CNA Representative to ANC-East passes on consent**; Jennifer Potter-Miller will also attend ANC-East meeting next week; CNA revised response letter to ANC-East attached with these notes
