## **Cherrywood Buddy System during COVID-19**

Neighborhoods are the first level of community beyond our households. Cherrywood has a rich history of interacting with each other as a community for fun and enjoyment which has created a lot of positive social capital. Challenging times like these are the time to draw on some of that social capital.

The Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) has identified older adults – those ages 60 and older – and people who have severe chronic medical conditions such as heart, lung, or kidney disease to be at higher risk for more serious COVID-19 illness.

The current guidance for preventing the spread of COVID-19 is strict social distancing and self-isolation. We fully support the public health guidance for all neighborhood residents, even as it evolves, but we also recognize this strategy may isolate some residents from people who are able and willing to help them through COVID-19.
